Children under the age of 16 years as at 1st September 2006, must be accompanied by an adult (over 18 years of age). I release and indemnify the organisers, sponsors and others involved in the event (including Bicycle New South Wales) from and against any claims, liability, costs and expenses made, suffered or taken by any person or body as a result of my/our participation in the event.
